We are happy to announce that coming in the summer/early fall of this year, Eye to Eye will be relocating to our new home! Do not worry, however, the new location is still in the Unionville/Chadds Ford School District, only a few miles away from our current location. In fact, we will be closer or about the same distance away for the majority of our patients.

Our new location is 1008 Unionville - Wawaset Rd, Kennett Square. We are in the process of converting this beautiful 1890's farmhouse into a state of the art, expanded location for our office. It is in beautiful Newlin Township, halfway between Northbrook Orchards and Unionville on SR842 (Unionville-Wawaset Rd). We will have ample free parking as well as full handicap accessibility. The building will house 4 exams rooms, a large waiting area, a dilating waiting area, as well as a contact lens room and a surgical scheduling suite. Construction is under way now and we will be sending a special notice out when we firm up a move in date.

Dr. Lusavage is now a volunteer at Community Volunteers in Medicine in West Chester. This facility is a clinic for the working poor of Chester County. The doctor goes there once a month to perform free eye exams for their patients. She also gives talks to the staff on common eye ailments.
